**AC1 - Allan Herschell Company Records, Swinson Collection, 1925-1984 (bulk 1940-1969)**

Creator: Allan Herschell Company

Description: Collection documents the amusement ride industry's history in North Tonawanda, New York and the development of the amusement industry. Collection includes extensive photographs, marketing images, slides, negatives, motion picture film, correspondence, blueprints, mechanical sketches, notes, customer orders, and documentation of competitor's rides. Rides documented include roller coasters, merry-go-rounds, miniature passenger trains, ferris wheels, and others.

Extent: 21 manuscript boxes, 4 oversized boxes, 1 triangular box, 8 other boxes (11.75 cubic feet)

**AC2 – Armitage-Herschell Company Records,**

Creator: Armitage-Herschell Company; General

Description: Includes receipts, account books, photographs of contemporary drawings, amusement ride information and photographs, letterhead, and photocopied catalogs. Contains 1884 photograph of Allan Herschell with ridding gallery in Bombay, India.

**AC3 – Land Contracts, 1873-1937, 1979**

**AC6 – Allan F. Herschell Papers,**

Creator: Herschell, Allan F. [Grandson of Allan Herschell]

Description: Contains family papers: citizenship papers, family photographs, correspondence, birth certificates, family history, calendars, clippings, and notes of 1894 Bombay carrousel.

Extent: 1 letter manuscript box (0.36 cubic feet)

**AC7 – Herschell-Spillman Company Records,**

Creator: Herschell-Spillman Company; General

Description: Contains incorporation papers; correspondence; photographs of employees, buildings, and rides; catalogs, and drawings.

### **AC11 – Dave Baer Papers,**

Creator: Baer, David [Sales manager of Allan Herschell Division at Lisk-Savory]

Description: Contains Chance catalog announcements; 1969 ride inventory; correspondence; blank order forms; publications on amusement industry; insurance plans for rides; price lists; catalogs; and ride flyers, photographs, and service instructions.

Extent: 2 letter manuscript boxes (0.72 cubic feet)

### **AC12 – Mary (Wendler) Misklea Papers,**

Creator: Misklea, Mary Wendler

Description: Contains photographs of carrousel animals, John Wendler, employees, and rides; flyers; catalogs; clippings; correspondence; business calendar and correspondence of John Wendler; and subject file on Bill Wendler's death.

### **AC13 – A. Watson Bray Papers,**

Creator: Bray, A. Watson [Vice President and General Manager of the Allan Herschell Company division at Lisk-Savory]

Description: Contains flyer for sale or lease of Oliver and Geneva street plants; union agreements; price lists; brochures; catalogs; flyers, photographs, and service instructions for rides; sales notebooks, ride specifications, clippings of article by Bray in December 1965 *Amusement Business*.

Extent: 2 ½ letter manuscript boxes (0.90 cubic feet)

### **AC14 – Wurlitzer Company Records,**

Creator: Wurlitzer Company; General

Description: Contains catalogs, factory photographs, service instructions, centennial cookbook, clippings, notes on company's history, list of band organ music rolls, and photographs of employees, buildings, machinery, pianos, and organs.

**AC16 – Earl Dealing Papers,**

Creator: Dealing, Earl [Owner/operator of Dealing's Park in Amherst, NY]

Description: Contains photographs of carrousel's at Dealing's Park; Allan Herschell Company catalogs, ride photographs; Allan Herschell Company and Miniature Train Company price list; competitor's price lists, catalogs, and brochures; letterhead; *Spillman Magazine* Vol. 1., No. 2; photographs and clippings of Kenmore Tonawanda Jaycees on rides; biography; and obituary.
